A wrestler must have many qualities to beat his rivals. He must be strong and very quick. Then he needs enough strength to tear the rival from the mat and throw him on the floor.

I will tell you about myself. I grew up tall and thin with no great strength in my arms. Wrestling came into my life when I was 18. I was 188 cm tall and weighed 85 kg and could not compete with my rivals in strength.

Then I decided to build up my muscles. I developed a system of exercises, which helped me to become stronger. I spent much time weight lifting. I lifted a bar equal to my own weight, which is up to 100 kg. However, that happened after two years of regular exercising. At first, the weight was only 30-40 kg. In general, I advise to choose the weight, which is twice as small as your own.

Push-ups were also of great help to me. At first, I could push up only 3 or 4 times, so weak were my arms! Then 30 times. Interesting enough, if you strengthen your legs, you feel as if your body has become much lighter. It is a very useful exercise. I also worked with dumb-bells and weights and threw heavy stones into air. You must combine muscle-building exercises with long distance running. It is a good relaxation for the arms and back muscles.

I was considered the strongest heavyweight wrestler in the world. However, I have never been the biggest among my rivals. I weighed a little over 100 kg but defeated even those who weighed 120, 150 and 180 kg like the American Chris Taylor whom I threw on the floor at the 1972 Olympics. If you are strong, you do not fear any rivals! My advice to you is if you want to be strong, take up physical exercises at once.

A Symbol of Paris

Being one of the most popular sites in the world, the Eiffel Tower attracts hundreds of thousands of tourists every year. In fact, the structure, received its two hundredth millionth guest in 2002. What is *extreme ironing*? Extreme ironing is pressing clothes in very difficult places. Ironists must carry their irons, ironing boards, and wrinkled laundry with them to the competition site. Some ironists take electric generators. Others heat their irons on gas stoves. The competitors get more points for the difficulty of the location. However, the quality of the ironing is important, too. Each item must be well pressed.

Extreme ironists compete in some amazing places. **Entrants** iron while they are climbing rocks, climbing mountains, and climbing trees. They iron in canoes, on the backs of cows, and even underwater. One team ironed while on a kayak in the Atlantic Ocean.

This sport is not a joke. Teams from 30 countries competed in the first world championships in Germany in 2002. Phil Shaw is the inventor of extreme ironing. He says that there are about 1,500 ironists worldwide. Some teams have corporate sponsors. The German corporation Rowenta, an iron maker, pays for Shaw's team. The goal of extreme ironists is to have their sport included in the Olympics. Maybe then they can start using their real names. At the moment, **contestants** use names such as Steam, Cool Silk, and Iron Man. Why? Shaw admits, "Most **competitors** don't want people to know that they are ironists."

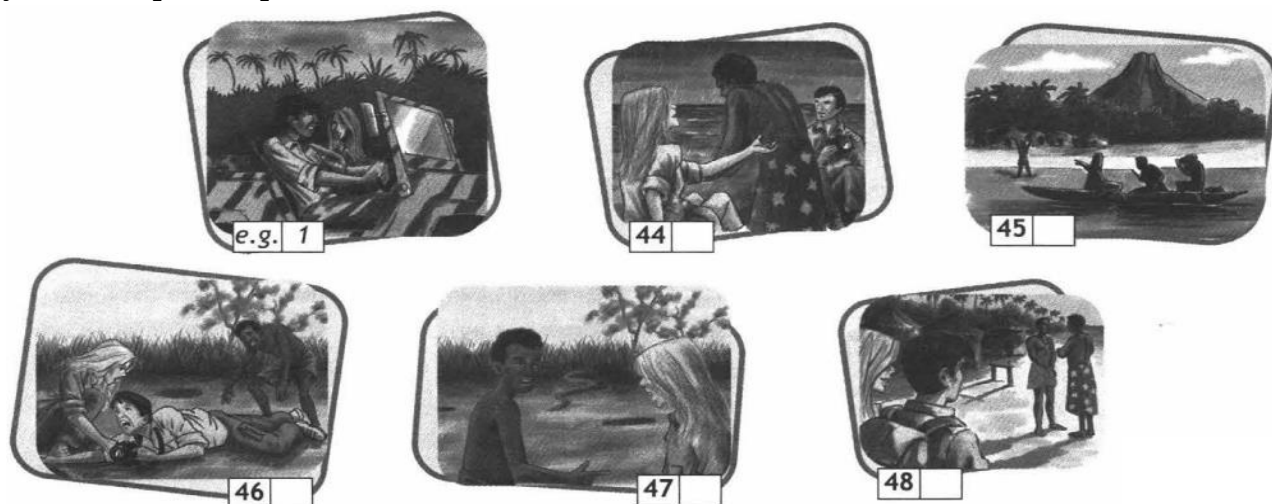

A. There are several stories which tell us why people decorate Christmas trees at home. One of them is about Martin Luther, the founder of the protestant faith. While he was walking through a forest on a Christmas Eve, he looked up and was impressed by the beauty of stars that were shining through the tree branches. He cut down a small tree and took it home. There, he decorated the tree with candles as a present for his family.

B. The tradition of decorating a Christmas tree comes from Germany. Until the 17th century, people followed strict rules when they decorated their Christmas tree. Firstly, a star was fixed on

the top. Then people hung apples on lower branches of the tree. Finally, they placed biscuits, gingerbread and sweets underneath. The Christmas tree in the fairy tale Nutcracker was decorated in exactly this way.

C. Later, the order of decorations lost its importance. The first decorations were all hand-made and good to eat but rather dull. To make the tree look brighter people wrapped nuts and gingerbread in metal foil and also made painted wooden toys. To illuminate the tree small candles were stuck to the branches. To protect the tree from fire, the candles were placed inside glass stands.

D. The Christmas tree tradition came to Russia with Peter the Great in the 18th century. He enjoyed the celebration tradition in Germany and issued a law according to which all the families had to decorate their houses with pine tree branches. It was also announced that people should have fun on that day. Peter the Great also decided to move the New Year date from 1st September to 1st January.

E. The most popular Christmas decoration was invented by a German glass-blower who made a ball and decorated it with angel figures and snowflakes. He gave it as a gift to his daughter. The girl decided to put the ball on the Christmas tree. It was so beautiful that the glass-blower made many more decorated balls. It is believed that this man started the tradition of decorating the tree with coloured glass balls.

F. In the 18th century, people started decorating Christmas trees with candles. Later, with the discovery of electricity, electric lights were put on Christmas trees. It was Edward Johnson, an assistant of Thomas Edison, who first used electric lights for Christmas tree decoration. People liked his idea. However, it took several years before the electric lights became available to the general public.

Red Nose Day

There's one special day in Britain when you can see lots of people all over the country wearing clown red noses. This is known as Red Nose Day. It's arranged by a charity organisation 'Comic Relief' whose aim is to collect money for people who are in need.

'Comic Relief' was started in 1985 by the writer Richard Curtis and the comedian Lenny Henry. At that time, people in Ethiopia were suffering from an awful hunger and something had to be done. The idea was simple. Richard and Lenny decided to gather a group of much-loved British comedians to give public performances. And in this way they would collect money to help people in desperate need. They also hoped to let people know about poverty in Africa. Richard and Lenny strongly believe that laughter is the best weapon to fight tragedy, poverty and injustice. That was how 'Comic Relief' was born.

One of the main events organised by 'Comic Relief' is Red Nose Day. It takes place every two years in the spring, though many people think that this day should be held annually. The first Red Nose Day was held on 5 February 1988 and since then they have been held on the second or third Friday in March.

The event is widely celebrated in the UK and many people consider it to be a type of unofficial national holiday. The symbol of the day is the red nose which you can find in various supermarkets and charity shops. The thing is that red noses are not sold and you cannot buy them, but you can leave a small sum of money (a donation) and just take one. The exact sum of the donation is not fixed. You can leave as much as you want – it's an act of charity.

Since 1985 there have been all kinds of noses: plastic, soft, boring common ones, there were noses that looked like faces, noses that made noises, noses that changed colour when they got hot... This year it's a dinosaur theme, which means noses are shaped like small creatures from pre-history. On Red Nose Day money-raising events take place all over the country and many schools participate.

In the evening of Red Nose Day a 'telethon' takes place on the BBC channels. This is like a televised marathon that shows a selection of the events of the day, and lots of short comic performances and reports of how the money will be spent. It starts in the evening and goes through into the early hours of the morning.

There's a Red Nose Day page on Facebook and you can follow it on Twitter. People also upload videos of local charity events on YouTube and Facebook.

So, if you are ever in the UK on Red Nose Day, now you know why you will find normal people wearing red noses and doing silly things! It's all for a good reason!

In addition to the main computer, each child has his or her own computer station, complete with laser printer, just like Larry's.

It takes an army of helpers, dozens of machines and clockwork precision to make it all work. But then precision is something the family knows all about, for this is a house that computers have designed. Larry is a founder of the company which has built up its business providing computer software for small firms. Larry talks as he takes us on a four-hour tour of the mansion.

"I've always been fascinated by computers. In fact, I was brought up with them – worked with them since the age of fourteen! I've been lucky, though, because I've always had good people to work for me. But I think my real strength is that I've done every single job in the company myself, so I know just what's involved in each one.

We've got three hundred and fifteen employees at the moment and we've still taking people on. That's not to say that we haven't had some scary moments, of course. Like when we had to borrow money to pay the bills. I really hated being in debt, but it's actually worked out well for us. We're also bought four or five other small companies along the way. I suppose we came to Dallas mainly for the children's sake, because the schools here are wonderful... and I've also worked out that I get a couple of hours a day more with the children – you see, the office is so close to home!"

Moderator: Today on the show we will talk with Dave Bradley from Her Majesty's Coast Guard. So, Dave, tell us about your work.

Dave: Well, I work at the Marine Rescue Coordination Center. It is one of 19 centers across the country with more than 400 specialized local coast guard rescue teams. My team is

based in Dover and we are responsible for helping people in need mainly at sea, but also on the rocks or along the coastline of the UK. In total, it covers an area of 1 million square nautical miles from the sea and 10 thousand nautical miles of coastline. We provide 24-hour service, encountering incoming distress signals and coordinating the efforts of rescuers. That's our main role, but that's not all we do. It is also our responsibility to respond to reports of marine pollution, as well as to use our knowledge and experience to prevent accidents. This is very important because it can reduce the number of emergencies. We provide safety training for everyone who goes sailing (to earn money, or for fun), as well as conduct safety talks for students in colleges and schools.

We are called for all kinds of emergency situations, such as helping people who got into bad weather while swimming, helping people who got into trouble while swimming or engaged in water sports, in particular, windsurfing. We also get a lot of calls to find the missing. Often they are modestly dressed, and they become too cold to help themselves. To help us successfully rescue people in a number of different situations at sea and on land, we have four search and rescue helicopters and four emergency tugboats that are also capable of fighting fire, as well as a fleet of patrol boats. Further, we have more than 3,500 volunteers in the Coast Guard Rescue Service all along the coast of the country who have been specially trained for search and rescue operations and who have special knowledge of their fields. All this is present, not to mention special rescuers specializing in rocks, all over the UK. These are the people who are our most valuable asset and together we are doing everything we can to help people who are in trouble. In 2005 alone, we dealt with 16,794 cases.

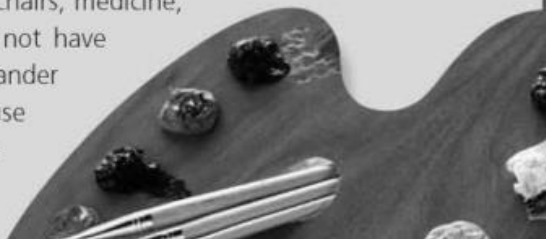

Indeed, Alexander Vereinov is an inspirational example of being able to use your inner strength and determination to become successful and then use this success to help others.

1. Назначение проверочной работы

Диагностическая работа проводится с целью определения уровня сформированности функциональной грамотности у учащихся 8-х классов, а именно следующие направления: читательская грамотность, финансовая грамотность, креативное мышление.

Чтение:

Оценка «5» ставится обучающемуся, если он понял основное содержание иноязычного текста, может выделить основную мысль, определить основные факты, умеет догадываться о значении незнакомых слов, изредка обращается к словарю. Произношение и интонация иностранного языка соблюдаются. Чтение беглое.

Оценка «4» ставится ученику, если он понял основное содержание текста, может выделить основную мысль, определить отдельные факты. Однако у него недостаточно развита языковая догадка, и он вынужден чаще обращаться к словарю. Произношение и интонация иностранного языка в основном соблюдаются. Чтение плавное, немного замедленное.

Оценка «3» ставится школьнику, который не совсем точно понял основное содержание прочитанного, умеет выделить в тексте только небольшое количество фактов, языковая догадка не развита, постоянно обращается к словарю. Ошибки в произношении и интонации. Чтение замедленное.

Оценка «2» выставляется ученику в том случае, если он не понял текст или понял содержание текста неправильно, не ориентируется в тексте при поиске определенных фактов, с трудом может найти незнакомые слова в словаре. Много произносительных и интонационных ошибок. Чтение медленное, прерывистое. При оценивании навыков чтения детей с ТНР не учитываются некоторые фонетические и интонационные ошибки, темп чтения. Объем текста может быть сокращён на 1/3 – 1/2 в зависимости от структуры речевого дефекта.

Понимание речи на слух (аудирование):

Оценка «5» ставится ученику, который понял основные факты, сумел выделить необходимую информацию, догадался о значении части незнакомых слов по контексту, сумел использовать информацию для решения поставленной коммуникативной задачи.

Оценка «4» ставится ученику, который понял не все основные факты. При решении коммуникативной задачи он использовал только 2/3 информации. Оценка «3» свидетельствует, что ученик понял только 50 % текста. Отдельные факты понял неправильно. Не сумел полностью решить поставленную перед ним коммуникативную задачу.

Оценка «2» ставится, если ученик понял менее 50 % текста и выделил из него менее половины основных фактов. Он не смог решить поставленную перед ним речевую задачу. Для детей с ТНР оценка за аудирование не является обязательной и может не выставляться в журнал. Задания на аудирование выполняются только в целях коррекционно-развивающего обучения.

Говорение:

Основными критериями оценки умений говорения следует считать: – соответствие теме, – достаточный объем высказывания, – разнообразие языковых средств и т. п., – ошибки целесообразно рассматривать как дополнительный критерий.

Оценка «5» ставится, если высказывание соответствовало поставленной коммуникативной задаче, и при этом устная речь полностью соответствовала нормам иностранного языка в пределах программных требований.

Оценка «4» выставляется учащемуся, если высказывание соответствовало поставленной коммуникативной задаче, мысли на иностранном языке изложены с незначительными отклонениями от языковых норм, устная речь в целом соответствовала нормам иностранного языка в пределах программных требований.

Оценка «3» ставится ученику, если высказывание соответствовало поставленной коммуникативной задаче, мысли на иностранном языке выражены с отклонениями от языковых норм, не мешающих понять основное содержание сказанного.

Оценка «2» ставится ученику, если высказывание не соответствовало поставленной коммуникативной задаче, мысли на иностранном языке выражены с отклонениями от языковых норм, которые не позволяют понять содержание большей части сказанного. Для детей с ТНР объем речевого высказывания может быть сокращён на 1/3 – 1/2 в зависимости от структуры речевого дефекта. При выставлении оценки не учитываются некоторые фонетические и интонационные ошибки, темп речи.

Оценивание письменной речи обучающихся:

Оценка «5» Коммуникативная задача решена, соблюдены основные правила оформления текста, очень незначительное количество орфографических и лексикограмматических погрешностей. Логичное и последовательное изложение материала с делением текста на абзацы, не мешающих пониманию текста. Правильное использование различных средств передачи логической связи между отдельными частями текста. Богатый словарный запас.

Оценка «4» Коммуникативная задача решена, но имеются лексико-грамматические и орфографические погрешности, не препятствующие пониманию. Мысли изложены в основном логично. Допустимы отдельные недостатки при делении текста на абзацы и при использовании средств передачи логической связи между отдельными частями. Достаточный словарный запас.

Оценка «3» Коммуникативная задача решена, но есть лексико-грамматические, орфографические, пунктуационные погрешности, препятствующие пониманию текста. Мысли не всегда изложены логично. Деление текста на абзацы недостаточно последовательно или вообще отсутствует. Ошибки в использовании средств передачи

логической связи между отдельными частями текста. Запас слов ограничен, не всегда соблюдаются нормы иностранного языка.

Оценка «2» Коммуникативная задача не решена. Отсутствует логика в построении высказывания. Не используются средства передачи логической связи между частями текста. Учащийся не может правильно использовать свой лексический запас или не обладает необходимым запасом слов. Грамматические правила не соблюдаются. Правила орфографии и пунктуации не соблюдаются. При оценивании навыков письма детей с ТНР дисграфические ошибки учитываются как одна. Объём письменного задания может быть сокращён на $\frac{1}{3}$ – $\frac{1}{2}$ в зависимости от структуры речевого дефекта. 3.9.5.

Выполнение тестовых заданий оценивается по следующей схеме

Количество заданий для детей с ТНР может быть сокращено на $\frac{1}{3}$ – $\frac{1}{2}$ в зависимости от структуры речевого дефекта при сохранении действующих норм оценивания.
